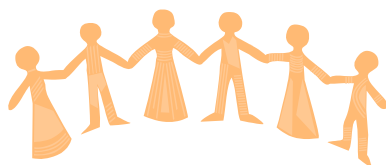
We could use your help

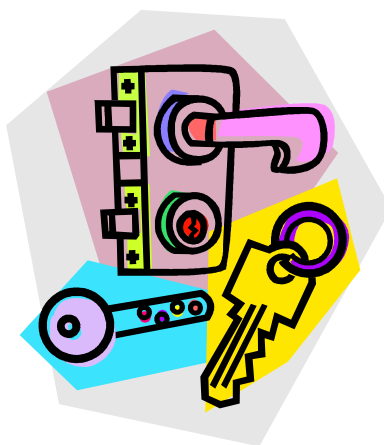

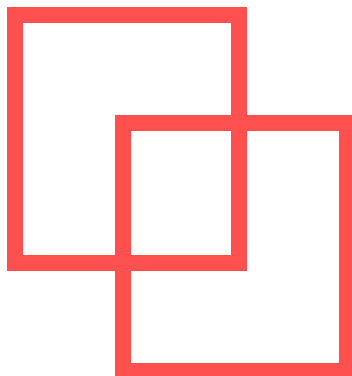

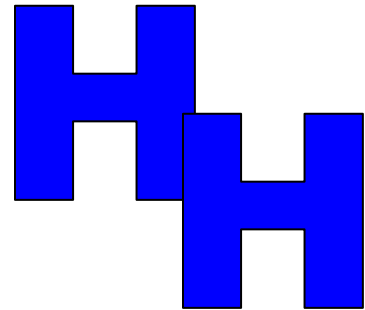
