**1. Minutes:**

Minutes were mailed with the meeting notice. Barb Dieterle moved that the minutes be approved as submitted; Clarita Maples seconded. Minutes were accepted.

**2. Treasurer's Report:**

Marilyn Peck reported the treasury balance, as of February 29, 2000, is \$23,088.32.

**3. Cleaning Committee Report:**

Nothing to report.

**4. Decorations Committee Report**

Barb Dieterle said that the committee is decorating on the first Saturday morning of the month.

## 5. Ongoing Maintenance Activities:

- **Floor Refinishing** - Ed Cordray reported that the contract has been finalized with Simpson Flooring. A \$500 deposit has been paid. It was suggested that a tarp be put up to cover the kitchen and cement area. Ed reported that Simpson already planned to put up a cover over the kitchen opening. He will check with them about the cement area. There was some confusion over if there is an election in May which is keeping us from starting the floor until May 3. Ed will contact the Board of Elections to verify if there is or isn't an election in May.

Ed also reported that when complete, the finish will not be slippery. To "speed up" the floor Simpson is recommending using a dust from refinishing or sawdust. The advantage of these products is that they are wood being worked into a wood floor. NEVER WAX A WOOD FLOOR. That just puts a coat on the floor that then has to be removed before the floor can be cleaned.

It is not known how often future cleaning of the floor will need to be done. It depends on it's usage. Ed plans to have Simpson inspect the floor every year until we understand how often it needs to be cleaned. Cleaning is a 3-day job, as opposed to the complete refinishing (2 weeks) we are having done this year.

Also related to the floor refinishing, it was pointed out that this will be a good time to clean out the cabinets and closets. Although dust is not supposed to be too bad, ensure that no damage is done to your cabinet contents by removing them before May. The curtains will be taken down and cleaned. There was discussion about rekeying the entry doors to ensure that no one enters the building during the floor work. This would also allow Ed to issue keys to clubs and know who has them. He would like to stamp them "do not copy" to reduce the number of extra keys that get made.

Karin Gurr moved that the entry doors be rekeyed right before the floor work begins. Second by Roy Gurr. Motion passed.

## 6. New Business:

- **Spring Work Day** - Ed would like to have a spring work day to clean up after the floor work and do other maintenance activities. He would like to schedule this for Sunday, May 14. There was some concern that this was Mother's Day and a request to do it on Saturday, May 13. The problem is that the floor will still be curing on that day. If there is not an election in May we may be able to have the work started a day or two earlier. Ed will check with the Board of Elections and Simpson Flooring to see if this is possible. Please wait to announce this event until the exact date is determined. Club delegates will be informed by postcard of the date. It was recommended that we should not only solicit workers but a committee to feed those workers also.
- **Pavilion Schedule** - Leslie Hyll asked about any corrections to the schedule that was sent out. There have recently been some 5<sup>th</sup> Fridays and 5<sup>th</sup> Saturdays that have passed without an event. We would like to know about these free dates now for 2001 so that we can solicit clubs for events. Phil Baumer clarified that the 5<sup>th</sup> Fridays belong to Fayvorite Rounds from Jan - Jun, and then to Dayton Whirlaways from Jul - Dec. Barb Dieterle pointed out that the 5<sup>th</sup> Saturdays were opened up for special council dances. Ed will ask the Council for its 2000/2001 dates at the next meeting so that we can determine if there are any free dates left.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 am.
