1. Minutes:

Minutes were mailed with the meeting notice. John Stocker moved that the minutes be approved as submitted; Ed Anderson seconded. Minutes were accepted.

2. Treasurer's Report:

Marilyn Peck reported the treasury balance, as of May 31, 2000, is \$14,643.84

3. Cleaning Committee Report:

No complaints. Marilyn requested that the plastic runner at the counter be replaced. Ed Cordray recommended that we remove all plastic covering as suggested by Simpson flooring and monitor the wear of the floor at the counter. Moisture get caught under the plastic causing excessive wear.

4. Decorations Committee Report

The pavilion will be decorated today after the meeting with butterflies for the summer.

5. Ongoing Maintenance Activities:

Tables - There is evidence of the tables being dragged across the floor. Please don't. Get help if you need to move the tables.

Work day - The work day was a huge success. Thanks to all who participated.

Roof - The City of Dayton does not have the manpower this year to replace the roof, but is willing to continue to fix if any problems develop. Please call Ed Cordray if a leak is found so the problem can get fixed. If a leak is noted on the close-up sheets it may be several days to weeks before the problem is noted.

Flower beds - In the long term, Ed Cordray would like to see raised flower beds at the south side of the Pavilion and possibly on all four sides.

Sam's Club Membership - The membership has been renewed.

Natural Gas service - The City (via Trame Mechanical) will be installing new gas service to the pavilion. The meter will be located at Dorothy Lane. The line will be trenched across the parking lot. While the line is being installed, we will lose gas service. The date this will happen is unknown.

Signage - A locking sign case (bulletin board) lists for \$300.00 to \$600.00 depending on size. Tom Dieterle has a couple of 4 foot by 8 foot banners that we might be able to use. Auggie Auckerman has proposed that we try and get a building ID sign that would also promote dancing. We need to get the City of Dayton's permission as well as the City of Kettering's.

Drapes - The drapery linings have started being replaced by Leslie Hyll. The linings cost about \$6.00 per panel (\$96.00 for all 8 windows). John Stocker moved that we allow Leslie to replace the linings as demonstrated in her own time and method. Roy Gurr seconded. Motion Passed.

6. New Business:
